REGULATORY NOTIFICATION

California Proposition 65- Lead and Lead Compounds

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm. The concentration of the listed chemical and the use of the product should also be considered when determining the potential exposure.

Lead and Lead compounds are listed on the Proposition 65 list due to causing birth defects or reproductive harm.

Inks produced by NUtec Digital Ink does not contain Lead and Lead compounds.

These inks have not been tested and compliance is based on information and specifications of the raw materials provided by the supplier or manufacturer. It is the responsibility of the end user to ensure compliance of the finished products.
